To all Entrants or possible Entrants to 2012 WCPF AV Competition:

Change to the Short Sequence (maximum length) from 4min 59sec (2011) to 3min 21sec (2012)

It appears that information about this years change for Short Sequences did not reach all entrants. Some people only became aware of the change when the Entry Form was published in mid-january. As preparation time for AV sequences can be quite long, this is not adequate notice. We apologise sincerely for any problems this has caused.

How the change was announced:

Notification in the AV section of the WCPF website for most of the past year
(The item was only removed when the new Entry Form went on)
It was flagged up at the October 2011 AGM
The minutes of the AGM were put on the website

However, we accept that the information did not reach everyone.
In hindsight, a direct mailing to AV workers would have been a good idea.

To clarify, for 2012:

Short Sequence maximum length: Up to 3min 21secs
Long Sequence maximum length: From 3min 22secs to 10mins

Sequences produced to a length between 3mins 21secs and 5mins will be judged in the Long category.
