**PAGB Awards for Photographic Merit WORKSHOP**  
**Sunday 2 April 2017 - from 10.00 am to 4.30 pm**  
**The Village Hall, Clyst St Mary, Nr Exeter, EX5 1AA**

Following the successful WCPF advisory workshops in 2010, 2012, 2013 & 2015 there has been demand for another workshop. This will particularly assist you if you are considering applying for a CPAGB or DPAGB Award at the forthcoming adjudication in November 2017 which will be hosted by the East Anglian Federation.

The aim is to provide advice on your images prior to the adjudications for the Awards. It will be organised by Russell McGowan (PAGB Awards Officer for the WCPF) and the three advisers are all PAGB Award adjudicators with considerable judging experience -

The morning will start with a short presentation explaining the Awards, followed by informal one to one advice sessions, looking at individual's work and receiving feedback on the standard. It is intended that you will have feedback sessions from at least 2 different advisers during the day on either prints or DPs (whichever you are entering for your award). There will also be examples on hand of recent successful applicants. If you wish to bring someone with you, tickets will also be available for an audience of "observers" who may view the one to one advice sessions from a discrete distance. Observers will gain an insight into the standards required should they be thinking of applying for an award in the future. Time invested in looking at images, and hearing the advice given, will definitely aid your understanding of what is needed to gain CPAGB or DPAGB Award but cannot guarantee success.

COST: £20 to bring your work for one to one advice, £8 if attending as an observer

Those intending to submit work for assessment are advised to bring more images than are needed for your submission. This will give the advisers scope to help you select the right images ie. bring up to 15 images for C and up to 22 for D (but please don't bring more than this!)

Hot drinks will be provided on arrival, but lunch arrangements are up to individuals. There is a pub and a garden centre close by but in the past, service has been slow, so packed lunches are advisable.

It is anticipated that there will be a high demand for the limited number of places available for "Advice" tickets. Bookings will be taken on a strictly first-come-first-served basis. When there are no advisory tickets left, observer tickets will be offered if still available. Please respond as soon as possible using the booking form below.
